

## **ACTIONS AND ADVICE FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE CURRENTLY PARTICIPATING IN ONE OF THE UCM INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY PROGRAMMES AND ARE AFFECTED BY THE SPREAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS**

### ***INCOMING STUDENTS***

1. If you decide to remain in Spain or if you must remain to continue your studies, you should follow the directions of the Spanish Health Authorities. You can find updated information on prevention measures and on how the University will work during this period of closure on the UCM website: [www.ucm.es](http://www.ucm.es). It is also recommended that you consult the websites of the authorities of the corresponding country of origin and contact the Consulate of the country of origin in Spain.
2. The decision to return to the country of origin is a personal matter to be decided by each student. In any case, the security measures adopted by the local Spanish authorities and those of the country of origin regarding permitted journeys must be taken into account. It is highly advisable to contact the Consulate of the country of origin in Spain before travelling.
3. In relation to the academic regime, given the exceptional nature of the situation, each case will be studied individually, in agreement with the partner institutions, to try to find the most favourable solution. We will always try to respect the work done, as well as trying to put the necessary means to complete those works that were interrupted.
